**THE ROYAL BIRKDALE GOLF CLUB (BOYS JUNIOR OPEN)

Conditions:

1. The competition will be by 18 holes of stroke play.
2. Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Committee (Rule 6-3a). However it is a condition of the competition that, if the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.
3. No player may employ a caddie. Penalty: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: Four strokes.
4. In the event of ties the result shall be determined in accordance with the rules of the E.G.U.

Entries

5. Entries shall be made only on the special Entry Form to be obtained from The Royal Birkdale Golf Club or its web site.
6. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status and shall sign the declaration to that effect contained in the Entry Form.
7. Entrants must be under the age of 18 at 00.00 hours on the 1 January 2010.
8. Entries will only be accepted from Boys whose playing handicaps do not exceed EIGHT strokes under the English Golf Unions' handicapping schemes.
9. THE EXACT HANDICAP CERTIFIED AT THE DATE OF ENTRY WILL BE USED FOR PURPOSES OF ENTRY ONLY.
10. Players shall enter through their Home Club. The Secretary of such club shall sign the declaration in the Entry Form that, to the best of his knowledge and belief, the entrant is eligible and conforms in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status.
11. Entries will be limited to 120 competitors. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries for the highest handicap competitors will be decided by ballot, using exact handicaps. The draw and starting time sheet will be sent to each competitor

12. Signing the form signifies permission to take photographs of entrants.

13. Entrance fee of £15, together with a fully completed Entry Form, must be received by Royal Birkdale Golf Club not later than Friday 30th July 2010.

14. Cheques should be made payable to The Royal Birkdale Golf Club.

15. The Entry Form must be fully completed and signed personally by the entrant. Entries will NOT be accepted by phone. Entrance Fees will not be refunded unless intimation of scratching is received before the closing date of entries, except for those entrants who may be balloted out and who do not subsequently compete. Entry Forms may be obtained through the website.

16. All entries will be subject to the approval of the Committee, which reserves the right to accept or refuse, or having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving reason for its decision. The Committee may also request the production of a Birth Certificate of any Competitor either before or during the Competition.

17. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any Competitor making a false statement on their Entry Form.

Prizes:

18. Prizes will be awarded:
- For the best net score
 - For the best gross score
 - For the best net score under the age of 15.
 - For the best net runner-up score
 - For the best gross runner-up score
 - For the best runner-up net score under the age of 15
 - For best net 3rd
 - For best net 4th
 - For best net 5th
 - For best net 6th

19. No competitor may be awarded more than one prize. If a competitor returns a score that would otherwise entitle her to be awarded more than one prize, she shall receive the prize first named in the list set out in the preceding paragraph.

Registration:

20. Competitors are requested to register at the Clubhouse on the day of the Competition at least 30 minutes before their starting times.
